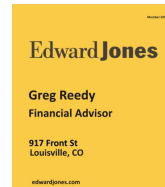

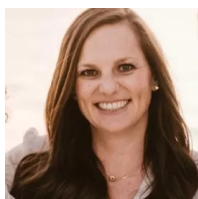
## **VOLUNTEERS!**

## **PTA Dollars at Work**

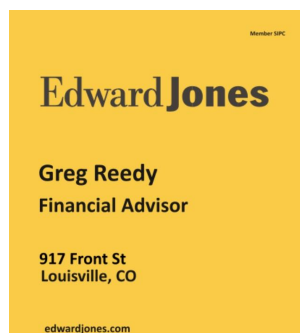
Ever wonder where the money you raise for the school goes? In this new section of the newsletter we'll highlight where the money is used!
