Dear Coal Creek Elementary Families,

The safety of all students is our number one priority at Coal Creek. Part of keeping students safe is knowing who is in our building at all times.

As you may have read in a letter from the district, the system checks each visitor's name and date of birth against the national database of registred sex offenders and other internal systems.

The system will:

- Electronically log visitors at check-in
- Print visitor badges
- Screen all visitors against a national sex offender database
- Provide school personnel and BVSD Security with real-time offender alerts The system will **Not**:
- Share data with outside agencies*
- Store the information you share

*BVSD's practice is to never ask for a student or parent's citizenship or immigration status. If we learn of a student's immigration status we would never share this with immigration officials.

New Check-In and Check-Out Procedures

Here's what to expect when you visit our school building during regular school hours:

- Access to a building will require that we scan your driver's license or photo ID to register you in the system (PLEASE REMEMBER TO BRING YOUR DRIVER'S LICENSE EVERY TIME YOU VISIT SCHOOL)
- Upon approval, an ID badge will print. Please wear this sticker during the remainder of your visit on campus or when attending a field trip.

Again, we are making these changes to ensure the safety of all students and staff. Additionally, we are extremely excited that this new system will allow us to resume volunteering in our school, not to mention that it will make the entire process of becoming a volunteer much simpler. The CBI Fingerprints that have been completed in the past will no longer be valid or available. You will now be required to complete an annual Raptor background check if you would like to volunteer within the school or assist with field trips. (Teachers will inform parents when volunteers are needed both in school and for field trips. A background check will be required for both of these activities.)
